

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF  
THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Best Chain Pharmacy Limited at G/F and M/F, 100A Castle Peak Road, Yuen Long, New Territories, has conducted an inquiry on 4 March 2016 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Best Chain Pharmacy Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Best Chain Pharmacy Limited, an authorized seller of poisons, was convicted of the following offences under the Trade Descriptions Ordinance, Chapter 362, Laws of Hong Kong, on 19 August 2015 at Fanling Magistrates' Courts, for which the following penalties were imposed:—

30 April 2014	Best Chain Pharmacy Limited	Supplying/Offering to supply false trade description goods	HK\$2,500
6 October 2014	Best Chain Pharmacy Limited	Possessing false trade description goods for sale/trade or manufacture	HK\$4,000

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that the Secretary of the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong should serve a warning letter on Best Chain Pharmacy Limited and that its decision in the inquiry should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
