PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Golden Peak Pharmacy O/B Golden Peak Pharmacy Limited at Shop A2, Ground Floor, 89 Sai Yee Street, Mong Kok, Kowloon, has conducted an inquiry on 13 November 2015 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Golden Peak Pharmacy O/B Golden Peak Pharmacy Limited, had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Golden Peak Pharmacy Limited operating Golden Peak Pharmacy, an authorized seller of poisons, was convicted of the following offences under the Pharmacy and Poisons Regulations, Chapter 138A, Laws of Hong Kong, on 21 May 2015 at Kowloon City Magistrates' Courts, for which the following penalties were imposed:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Golden Peak Pharmacy O/B Golden Peak Pharmacy Limited should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of ten days with effect from 26 December 2015. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
