

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF THE PHARMACY
AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong (‘the Ordinance’) to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Kin Fai Pharmacy O/B Born Super Company Limited, at Ground Floor, Tung Hing Building, 257 To Kwa Wan Road, To Kwa Wan, Kowloon, has conducted an inquiry on 2 September 2016 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Kin Fai Pharmacy O/B Born Super Company Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Mr. KWOK Ka-hung, employee of Kin Fai Pharmacy O/B Born Super Company Limited, an authorized seller of poisons, was convicted of the following offence under the Ordinance on 30 December 2015 at Kowloon City Magistrates’ Courts, for which the following penalty was imposed on 12 January 2016:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Kin Fai Pharmacy O/B Born Super Company Limited should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 3 days with effect from 15 October 2016. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
