## PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

## DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Prosperous Dispensary O/B Income Profit (HK) Limited, at Ground Floor, 216 Des Voeux Road West, Sheung Wan, Hong Kong, has conducted an inquiry on 18 December 2017 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Prosperous Dispensary O/B Income Profit (HK) Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Income Profit (HK) Limited operating Prosperous Dispensary, an authorized seller of poisons and its director, Mr. CHONG Nai-sing, were convicted of the following offences under the Ordinance and the Antibiotics Ordinance (Chapter 137, Laws of Hong Kong) on 17 July 2017 at Eastern Magistrates' Courts for which the following order was imposed:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Prosperous Dispensary O/B Income Profit (HK) Limited should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 2 days with effect from 30 January 2018. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
