

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE
OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Top Good Dispensary Limited, at Ground Floor, 42A Parkes Street, Jordan, Kowloon, has conducted an inquiry on 31 July 2015 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Top Good Dispensary Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Top Good Dispensary Limited, an authorized seller of poisons, and its manager Mr. LI Fuk-hung, were convicted of the following offences under the Ordinance and the Trade Descriptions Ordinance, Chapter 362, Laws of Hong Kong, respectively, on 13 April 2015 at Kwun Tong Magistrates' Courts, for which the following penalties were imposed:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Top Good Dispensary Limited should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 21 days with effect from 12 September 2015. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
