

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE
OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Kam Shing Mun Dispensary Limited, at Ground Floor, Yee Shuen Mansion, 52 Tai Wai Road, Tai Wai, New Territories, has conducted an inquiry on 30 May 2018 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Kam Shing Mun Dispensary Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Mr. LAW Chun-wai, being the director of Kam Shing Mun Dispensary Limited, an authorized seller of poisons, was convicted of the following offences under the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, Chapter 134, Laws of Hong Kong and the Ordinance on 6 December 2017 at Shatin Magistrates' Courts for which the following orders were imposed:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Kam Shing Mun Dispensary Limited should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 35 days with effect from 12 July 2018. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
