## PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

## DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong) to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Jubilant Medicine Shop O/B Lucky Noble Industries Limited, at Ground Floor & Mezzanine Floor, 345 Hennessy Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong has conducted an inquiry on 7 March 2025 in accordance with section 16 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Jubilant Medicine Shop O/B Lucky Noble Industries Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Jubilant Medicine Shop O/B Lucky Noble Industries Limited was convicted of the following offence under the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance on the date specified below at Eastern Magistrates' Courts for which the following order was imposed:—

In addition, the said Committee was satisfied that Jubilant Medicine Shop O/B Lucky Noble Industries Limited had failed to comply with sections 1.4h, 2e, 2f, 3.1e, 3.4d and 3.4g of the Code of Practice for Authorized Seller of Poisons (2021 version).

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, the said Committee directed Jubilant Medicine Shop O/B Lucky Noble Industries Limited be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 7 days with effect from 19 April 2025. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
