

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE
OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance (Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong) to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Brighton Pharmacy Limited, at G/F & M/F, 118 Nga Tsin Wai Road, Kowloon City, Kowloon has conducted an inquiry on 13 October 2023 in accordance with section 16 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Brighton Pharmacy Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Brighton Pharmacy Limited, its director Mr. CHUNG Wing-on and its employee Mr. CHAN Pak-hung were convicted of the following offences under the Trade Descriptions Ordinance (Chapter 362, Laws of Hong Kong) at Kowloon City Magistrates' Courts for which the following orders were imposed:—

In addition, the said Committee was satisfied that Brighton Pharmacy Limited, an authorized seller of poisons, had failed to comply with section 1.4b of the Code of Practice for Authorized Seller of Poisons.

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, the said Committee directed that a warning letter be served on Brighton Pharmacy Limited. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
